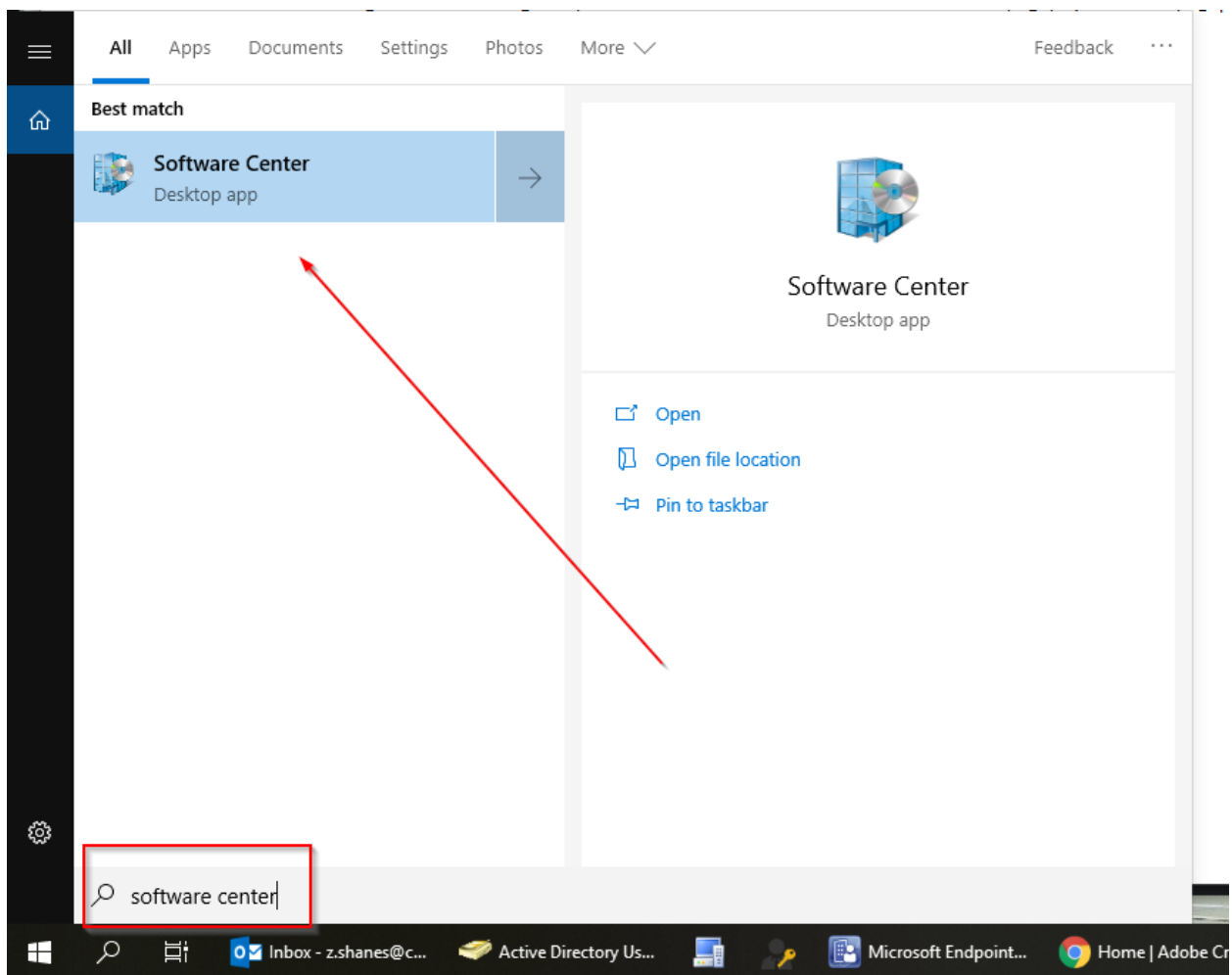


Installing Creative Cloud on a CSU-managed Windows computer (on campus)

If you:

- Have previous versions of Adobe software – Acrobat Pro or Photoshop, we recommend uninstalling them first
- Issues accessing the software center, or installing creative cloud following these steps, you may use the off-campus guide to install the software, both on or off campus.

1. First, search your machine for the Software Center by clicking the magnifying glass next to the Start Menu and typing in “Software Center”.



2. Select Applications, then select Adobe Creative Cloud, once found, click Install. The installation will take 5-10 minutes to complete. Installing Creative Cloud through the Software Center does not require elevated privileges.

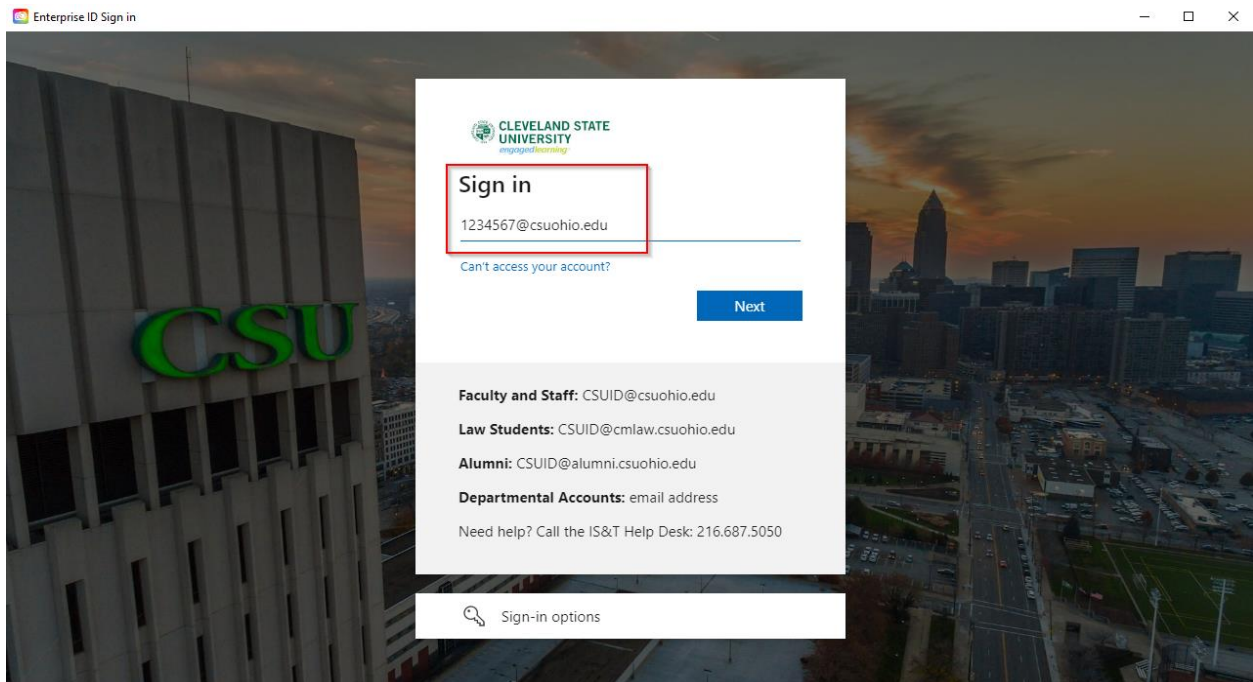
3. Once it has finished, you can find the Adobe Creative Cloud entry in the Start Menu. Open it.



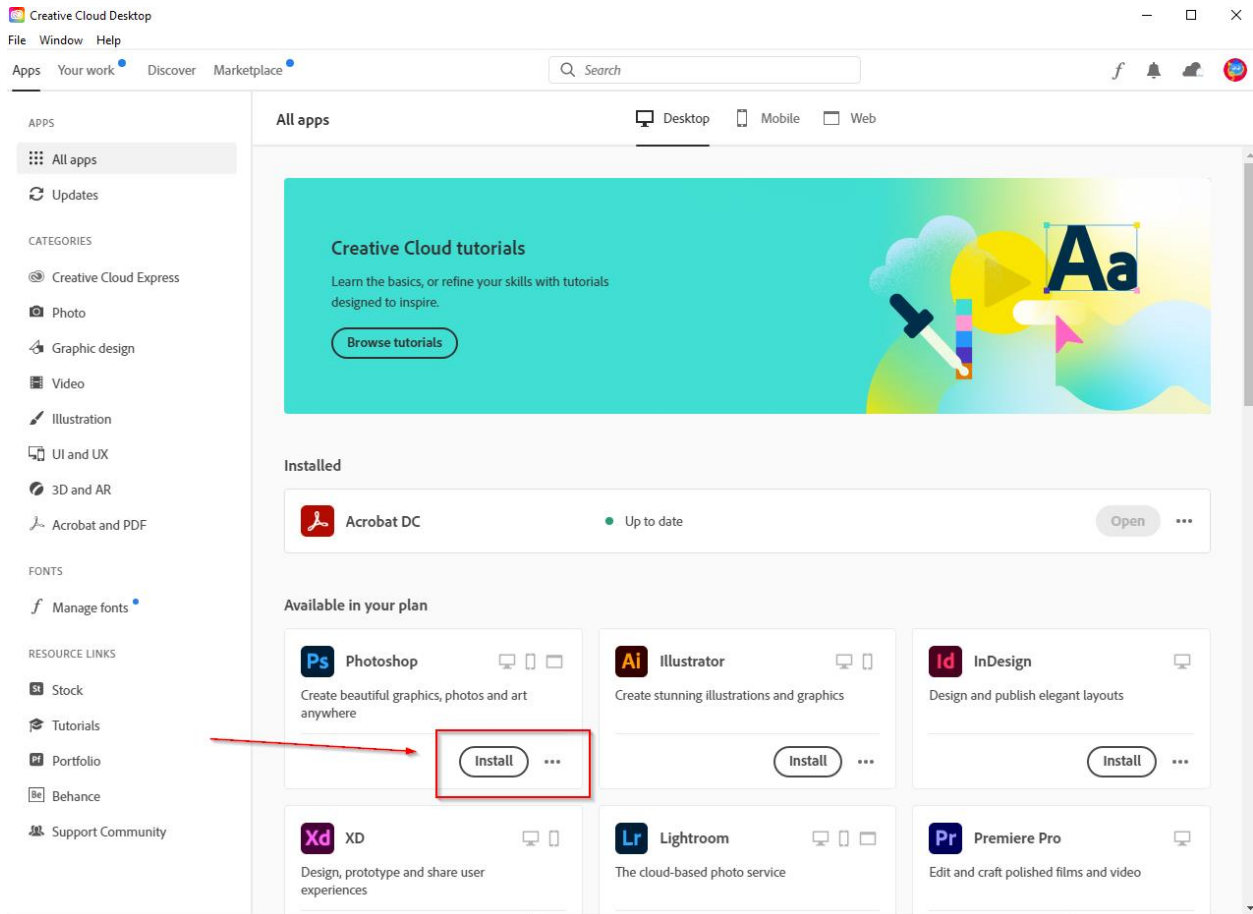
4. Once opened, use your csuid@csuohio.edu to sign in.



5. You will then sign in with the familiar SSO sign in screen.



- Once you are logged in, you can install Creative Cloud applications from the main page by clicking on the Install button beneath the application(s) you want to install.
