**JUNE E. TAYLOR** was appointed to the Cleveland State University Board of Trustees by Governor John R. Kasich on January 9, 2012 for a term ending on May 1, 2015, replacing Rev. Dr. Marvin A. McMickle. She was reappointed by Governor Kasich on May 14, 2015 to a full-term, beginning May 2, 2015 and ending May 1, 2024. Trustee Taylor currently serves as the Vice Chair to the CSU Board of Trustees.

June Taylor is President of MAC Installations & Consulting, LLC, a Cleveland-based technology firm providing low-voltage cabling, security, access control, media and sound masking systems. The firm offers solutions, incorporating the latest trends in technology, to enable hospitality, education and medical institutions in Northeast Ohio and throughout the Midwest to provide superior service.

Ms. Taylor received two degrees from Northwestern University: a Bachelor of Science in Industrial Engineering, and an MBA from the Kellogg Graduate School of Management with concentrations in finance and marketing.

Ms. Taylor was appointed by Governor Kasich to the Ohio Casino Control Commission, and currently serves as its Chair. She also serves on the Board of Trustees of the Sisters of Charity Foundation, focused on improving the lives of families, women and children, and Montefiore, a not-for-profit organization offering a comprehensive system of residential and community healthcare programs and services for seniors. Ms. Taylor is also a member of the City Council for Beachwood, Ohio.
