STEPHEN F. DUFFY, PH.D., was elected to the Cleveland State University Board of Trustees by the Faculty Senate for a term ending June 30, 2019. Dr. Duffy previously served on the Board from 2010-2013.

Dr. Duffy earned his Ph.D. in Engineering from The University of Akron in 1987, and has more than 35 years of experience as a practicing civil engineer. His primary fields of civil engineering practice are geotechnical engineering, site engineering, and various types of structural engineering design.

Dr. Duffy is a professor of civil and environmental engineering at Cleveland State teaching both undergraduate and graduate level courses. He has edited one book and authored/co-authored eight book chapters, along with being the primary author or co-author of 20 peer reviewed journal articles, and three industry standards one ISO standard and two ASTM standards. During his tenure at CSU, he has 21 successfully funded research grants, resulting in more than \$1 million in the field of engineering mechanics as it relates to the design components fabricated from brittle materials (e.g. ceramics, glass, and graphite) and \$1.5 million in federal funding for the University Transportation Center.

Dr. Duffy is the recipient of numerous awards for teaching, innovation, and research. He is a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, American Society of Mechanical Engineers, and American Society of Testing and Materials.
