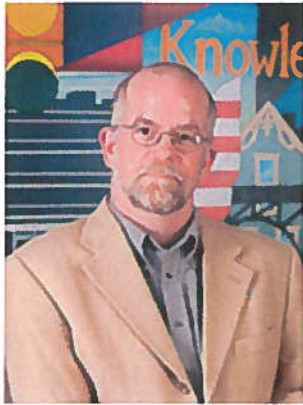

WILLIAM M. BOWEN, Ph.D., was elected President of the Faculty Senate, and serves as a Faculty Representative to the Board of Trustees for a one-year term, ending August 31, 2018. He previously served as the Faculty Representative to the Board of Trustees from 2000-2002.

Dr. Bowen is a Professor of Urban Studies and Public Administration at Cleveland State University in the Maxine Goodman Levin College of Urban Affairs. His research and teaching interests include research-based decision-making and problem solving in regional analysis and planning, especially in relation to economic development, energy policy, and environmental issues.

Dr. Bowen is the recipient of numerous awards for teaching, innovation, and research. His recent research has been published in: *The Journal of Urban Management*, *Economic Development Quarterly*, *Biodemography and Social Biology*, *The Journal of Urbanism*, *The Journal of Urban Affairs*, and the *Annals of Regional Science*. He received his Ph.D. in *Regional Analysis and Planning* from the *Indiana University at Bloomington*.
