Blue Light Emergency Phones

Throughout campus, provides immediate contact with CSUPD

CSU's Alert Messaging System

Notifies students of emergencies, closures and other time-sensitive campus updates

Security/Campus Safety Officers

Complements police patrols and serve as safety escorts for the campus community

Campus Safety Programs

The C.O.P.S. Program is specifically designed to create community outreach programming (special events, training, safety presentations) and provide opportunities for our police officers to build positive relationships within the campus community they serve.
