SI Garage Structural Beam Repairs

### Demolition – of Damaged Concrete Beams

When: November 3, 2014 – January 7, 2015 (REVISED)

Area affected: SI Garage, SI Building & SR Building – This portion of this project is for the structural repairs of the concrete beams under SI building. These are the beams that support the entire building and are located within the SI Garage. The beams have been damaged due to water infiltration from the existing roof drains. The existing roof drain pipes will also be replaced as a part of the repairs.

#### The hours of demolition will be 10:30 PM to 7:00 AM.

This demolition/repair portion of the construction will last an additional 3 weeks. The "Full" depth repairs were much greater than anticipated. Absolutely no parking on the upper deck until added steel has been installed. This should make the SI building structurally sound for the foreseeable future. This will also allow for the re-opening of the garage for Spring Semester.

#### **Anticipated disruptions: Demolition**

- Noise, Dust and Vibration.
- Closure of the SI Garage No parking until the structural repairs have been completed.

Thank you for your patience and understanding. With any construction project some disruption will likely occur, the contractors and our office will endeavor to minimize the impact when at all possible. Additional project updates will be forthcoming.
