

# Curriculog Update: New User Interface

In Summer 21, there was a system update that changed the user interface. In general, the new look is more user-friendly and intuitive. See below for a summary of what's different. All pop-up windows (i.e. Preview Curriculum, Impact Reports) look the same as before.

Navigation	Icons are always displayed	You had to hover for icons to appear
	Areas are labelled	You had to hover over the icon for the label to appear
	All the icons changed. <a href="#">Click here</a> to see.  Approve = Thumbs up Reject = Thumbs down Urgent = Fire Stuck = Life raft	Previously these were the icons: Approve = Green check mark Reject = Red X Urgent = Orange exclamation point Stuck = Blue exclamation point
Proposals	Click the proposal name to open it	In the past, this opened the proposal summary. You had to hover and click "View Proposal" to open the full proposal.
	When originating course or program modifications, you are walked through importing catalog information. An import is required by the system on some forms.	Importing was not required and the system did not walk through the process
	When viewing proposals, there's a sticky menu on the right so you don't have to scroll up to the top to enter a decision or to access files	You had to scroll back to the top to view these areas in the Proposal Toolbox
	When viewing proposals, you can minimize the right menu so the proposal is full screen	This view was not available before
	On program proposals, the "Prospective Curriculum" area is more intuitive with tabs and "Preview Curriculum" is it's own button	This area before had three icons and "Preview Curriculum" was buried
