The McNair Scholars Program is named after the late Dr. Ronald E. McNair, an African American physicist and NASA astronaut who perished in the explosion of the Challenger space shuttle in 1986.

Federally sponsored by the U.S. Department of Education, the program prepares participants for graduate and Ph.D. programs through involvement in research and other scholarly activities.

Participants come from underrepresented groups in higher education and/or from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, and they additionally demonstrate strong academic potential in STEM disciplines.






