Rid-All Green Partnership

Rid-All is an urban farm in Cleveland's Kinsman neighborhood. The Rid-All campus is comprised of two greenhouses, four hoop houses, a commercial composting station, a fish pond, a rain catchment pond, and a Native American-styled teepee. In addition to growing and selling numerous fruits and vegetables at the site, Rid-All has farm raised over 8,500 tilapia fish using a unique indoor aquaponics and hydroponics self-sustaining system that grows fish in tanks and vegetables on a connected top tier. The farm offers a number of youth programs and training opportunities for the community, attracting 4,000 annual visitors. The farm has been a summer job site for area youth and has hosted weddings, community festivals and concerts.
