As faculty and staff prepare to repopulate campus this summer, below are frequently asked questions that will assist with parking on campus:

Q What type of parking permits are available to purchase?

A We offer three (3) annual and semester permit options for faculty & staff:

- Prospect Permit – valid in Prospect Garage and South Garage
- Green Permit – valid in core campus parking facilities and South Garage
- White Permit – valid in perimeter campus parking facilities and South Garage

Q What are my parking options as a full-time employee?

A The best option for on-campus full-time employees is an annual permit. We recommend you purchase a prorated FY21 annual permit (valid through 7/31/21). Beginning July 1, you can purchase an FY22 annual permit (valid 8/1/21 through 7/31/22).

Q What are my parking options as a semester-based employee?

A Semester-based employees are eligible to purchase a semester permit. Summer permits are currently available for sale [online](#) (valid 5/15/21 through 8/13/21). Fall semester permits go on sale August 1 (valid 8/14/21 through 12/31/21).

Q What if I will only be on campus 1-2 days per week?

A An option for faculty and staff working a hybrid schedule is the pay-as-you-go semester permit. These permits are 'free' to purchase and function as a traditional parking permit in any of our gated garages. The only difference is a flat rate of \$6 must be paid on exit (cash or credit card). Pay-as-you-go permits are not valid in ungated facilities.

Q How much will a permit cost?

A All of our permit costs are prorated based on the date of purchase.

Q What are my payment options?

A Both annual and semester permits can be paid via payroll deduction or credit card. Please note that payroll deductions will be determined by the date purchased and the remaining balance on the permit selected. After July 5, FY21 annual permits will not be eligible for payroll deduction.

Q How do I purchase a parking permit?
