










VPN Client Installation-Windows 7 and 10 – Quick Reference

CSU is using OpenVPN to create a Virtual Private Network (VPN). VPN is a network that uses the Internet to provide individual users with secure access to an organization’s network (in this case, CSU’s network). These instructions are for Windows XP and Windows 7. The steps may vary slightly between the different web browsers (Internet Explorer (IE), Firefox (FF), Google Chrome (GC)).

Step 1	On your home computer, open a web browser and go to https://openvpn.csuohio.edu Sign in with your 7 digit CSU ID number and your CampusPass	
Step 2	Download the OpenVPN Connect for windows	
Step 3	Run the ‘openvpn-cconnect.msi’ installer that you just downloaded.	
Step 4	Follow the prompts on the Open VPN Client Setup Wizard.	
Step 5	Right click the OpenVPN logo and click on the ‘Connect’ option	
Step 6	Enter your CSU ID and Password in these fields and click connect	
Step 7	To disconnect Right click the OpenVPN logo in the bottom right corner and click ‘Disconnect’
