1. Open the Zoom mobile app. If you have not downloaded the Zoom mobile app yet, you can download it from the App Store.
2. After launching the Zoom app, Tap **Sign in**:



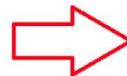

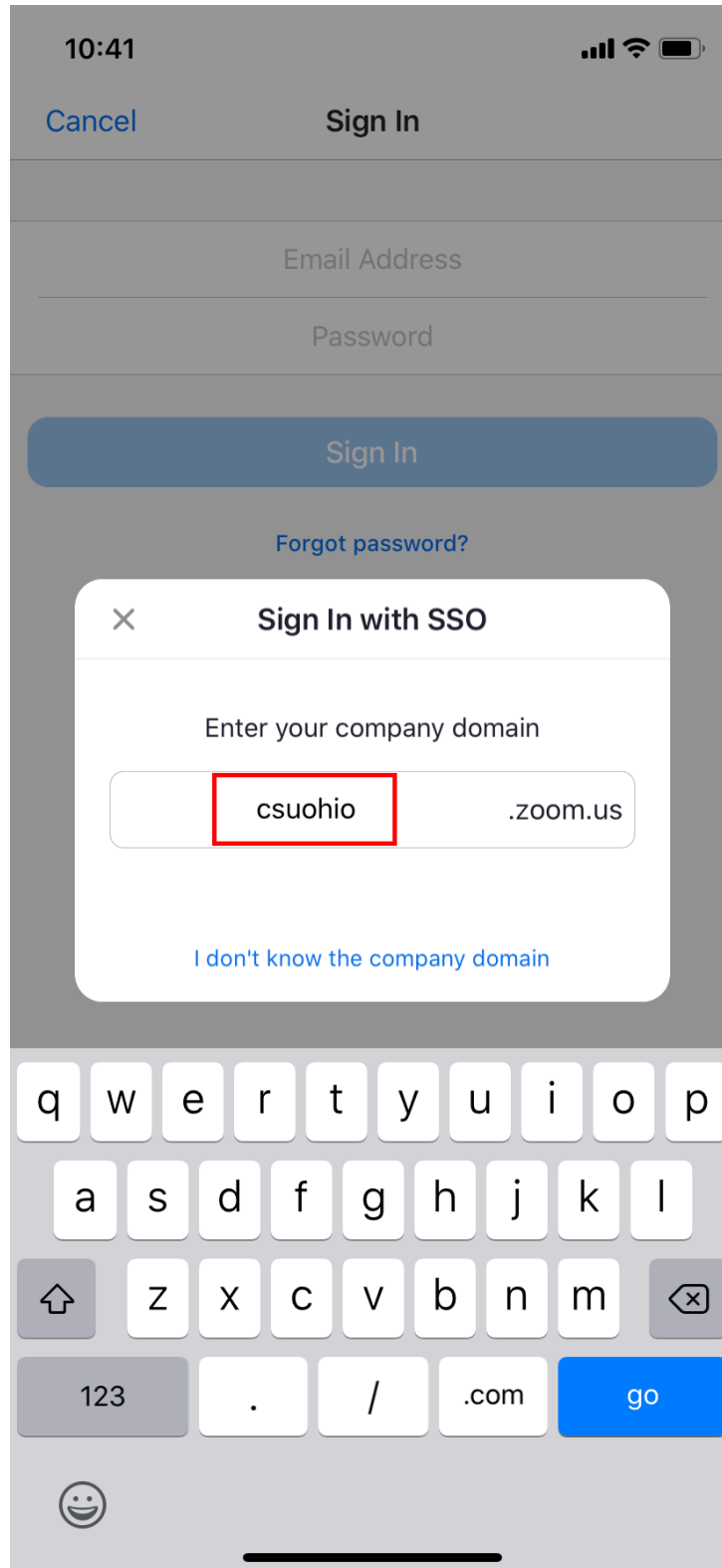

3. Under **SIGN IN WITH**, tap **SSO**:

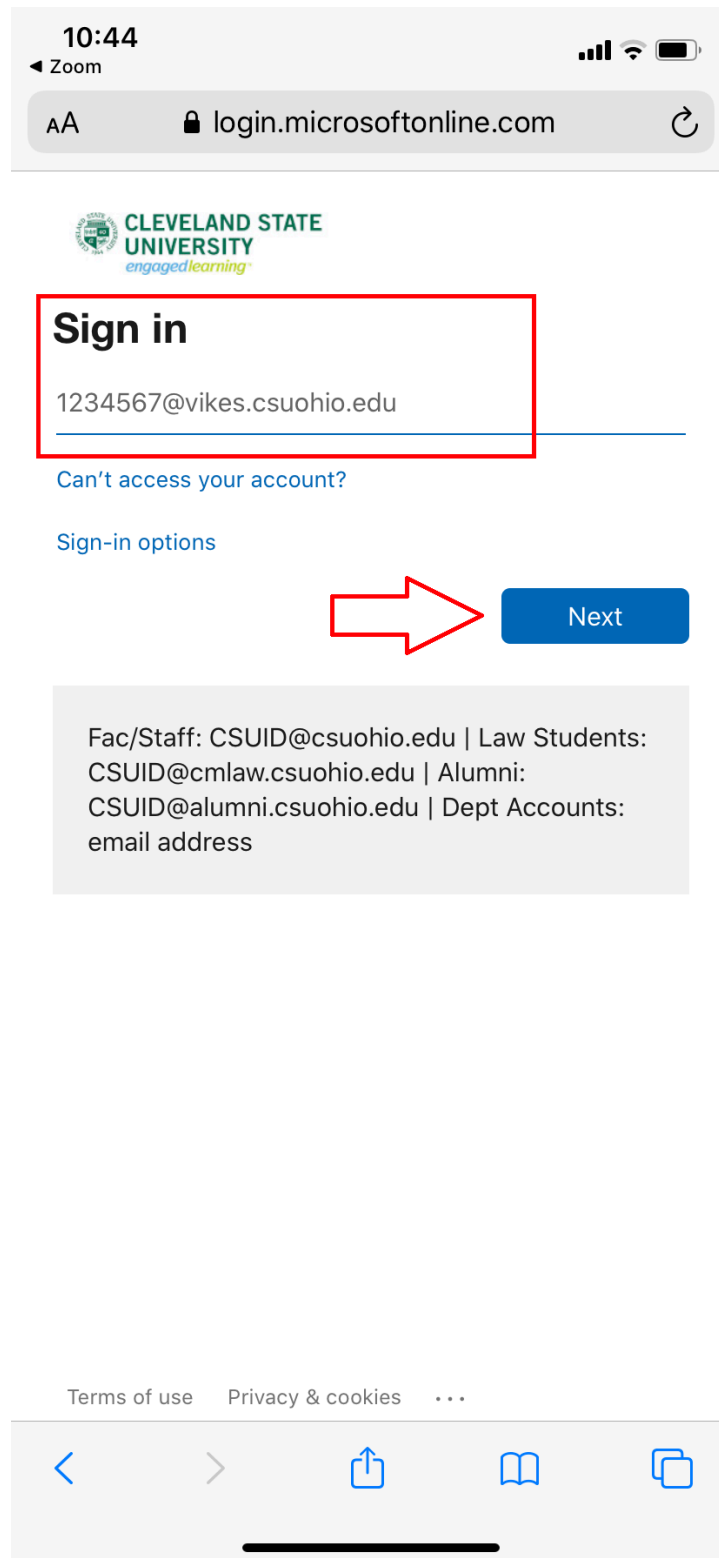



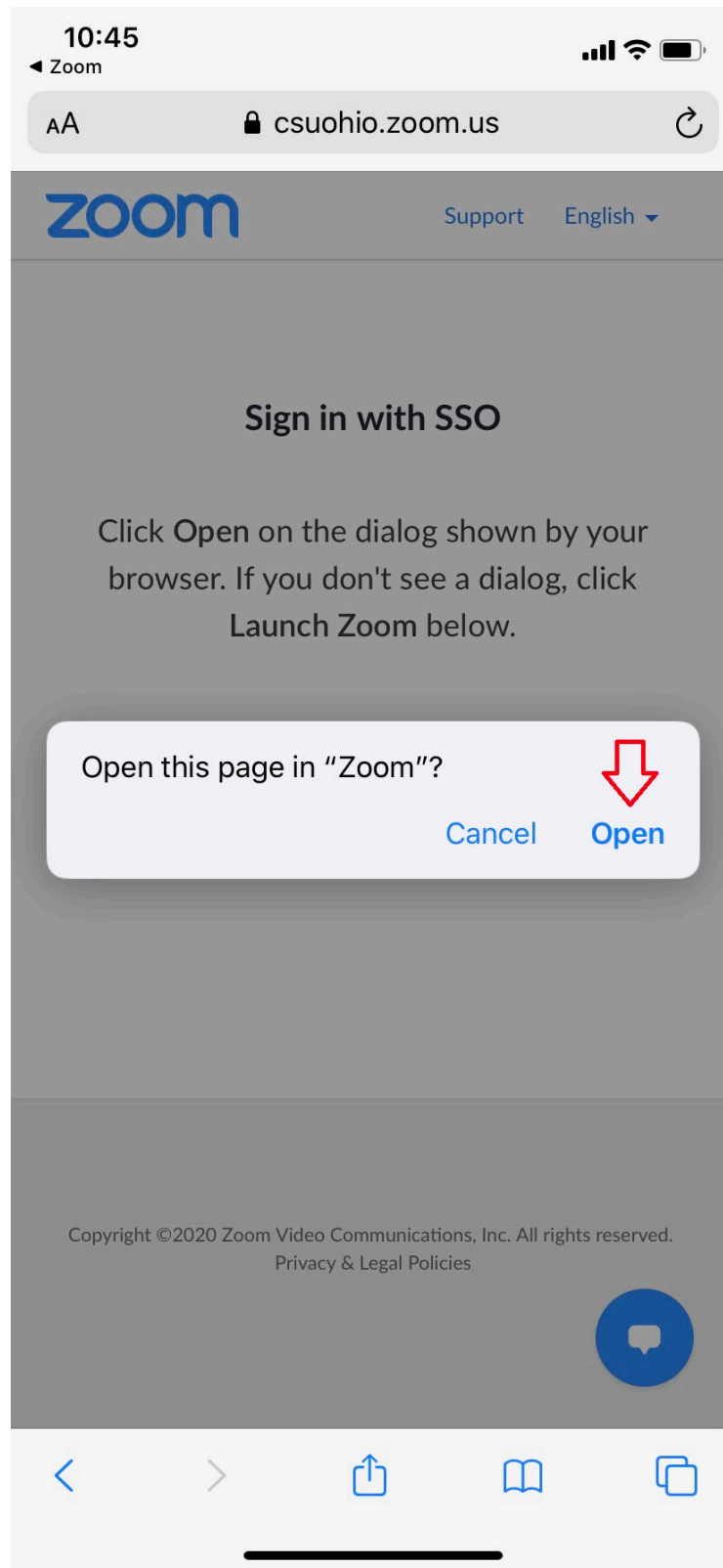
