Jerzy T. Sawicki

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Dr. Jerzy Sawicki is the newly appointed Senior Advisor to the Provost for External Partnerships as well as the D.E. Bently and A. Muszynska Endowed Chair and Professor of Mechanical Engineering. He is also the founder and director of the Center for Rotating Machinery Dynamics and Control

(RoMaDyC) in the Washkewicz College of Engineering at CSU. He is CSU's former Vice President for Research, and Chair and President of the CSU Research Corporation. Dr. Sawicki also has served as a research faculty fellow at the NASA Glenn Research Center and, from 2014-2017, he was a member of the Executive Committee of the Council on Research (CoR) of the Association of Public and Land-Grant Universities (APLU).

Since his arrival at CSU in 1993, Dr. Sawicki has authored more than 230 peerreviewed journal papers and conference articles, one research monograph, co-edited three books, and has supervised to completion more than 40 Ph.D. and M.S. students, and supervised more than 10 post-doctoral researchers and visiting scholars. Dr. Sawicki is the principal investigator of more than \$16 million in research grants and contracts. He currently serves as the Editor-in-Chief for the ASME Journal of Engineering for Gas Turbines and Power, as Chair of the International Gas Turbine Institute (IGTI) Structure and Dynamics Committee, and serves on the board of seven archival journals. He is a Fellow of ASME, U.S. representative to the ISO/TC 108/SC 2/WG 7 international committee, recipient of several Best Paper awards, the University Distinguished Faculty Award for Research, and the Siemens-Westinghouse Distinguished Speaker honor.
