

International Services

The voice and data plans that are added onto the phone at time of ordering are for domestic calls/data only (Continental US). If you are traveling out of the country, you would need to add an international plan to reduce expenses while away.

The plan would need to be added as close to the beginning of the billing cycle (the 10^{th} of the month) to make sure that you have the full amount or as close to the amount to eliminate prorated charges and minutes.

The plan can be added and removed at any time but must remain on the phone for at least 30 days after being added. To add one of these features, submit an email to Telecommunications at telcom@csuohio.edu
