Eligibility

- Current undergraduate student at Cleveland State University who is economically and/or socially disadvantaged
- Approved or eligible for general study abroad approval
- Studying abroad on an approved program that is 4 weeks or longer
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75

Attach a personal statement to this application form and submit both to the Center for International Services and Programs by the established scholarship deadlines. Essays should be double-spaced, typed, contain between 1,500-2,500 words and address the following:

- Reasons for applying for the scholarship
- Your social and/or economic need(s) for the scholarship (e.g. single mother who has to provide for child care, already receiving educational need-based scholarships or loans, not being able to work to earn money while abroad, etc.)
- How you plan to pay for your intended study abroad program with or without this scholarship
- Choice of study abroad program and how it advances your academic goals
