The Parker Hannifin Scholars scholarships are available to undergraduate students of all majors relevant to Parker's business (examples include: Engineering, Business, Accounting, Information Technology, Pre-Law and Human Resources) while the Washkewicz Scholars scholarships are reserved for students pursuing an undergraduate degree in Engineering. - Must be admitted to CSU prior to being awarded a scholarship
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.7
- Must have a minimum 23 ACT composite score or 1070 SAT consisting of combined critical reading and math (high school applicants)
- Must be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen as defined by the U.S. Dept. of Education
- · Must be an Ohio resident

Applicants will be evaluated by:

- · Overall portfolio
- GPA (grade point average)/class rank
- Standardized test scores (SAT/ACT)
- Scholastic honors achieved
- Financial need
- Written narrative (how well student presents himself/herself)
- Participation & honors achieved in extra-curricular activities (school organizations, community activities, etc.)
- · Interview session
- Dependents of Parker employees (up to age 26) will receive preference
- · Ability to relocate for a potential internship, co-op, and/or permanent career opportunity
